Allegations:

The subject member engaged in professional misconduct and in practice unbecoming a professional biologist.

Decision:

After full and careful consideration of the material contained in the file, the complaint was dismissed, with a recommendation that the subject member ensure that all professional communications are clear and complete.

After receiving and reviewing extensive submissions from both the complainant and the subject, the committee reached the conclusion that the subject member had not demonstrated incompetence or negligence. The Committee did note that it is important that professional communications are clear and complete so as to avoid the appearance of selective use of information.

Postscript:

The member is obligated to insure that all information is provided when preparing submissions for a client or employer so as to avoid the appearance and allegations of selective use of information.
