Complaint Summary:

The complainant alleged that the subject member, in their role as a RAR auditor, contravened the code of ethics by not providing a standard of care (Principle 3) was in conflict of interest (Principle 4) and injured the reputation of others (Principle 8).

Decision:

The Discipline Committee determined, after reviewing submissions from both parties involved that the file be dismissed.

Postscript:

In situations where one professional is reviewing the work of another members are encouraged to seek clarification with others or differing conclusions. This preliminary dialogue between professionals may clarify any differences and prevent miscommunications which could result in complaints filed with the College.
