Complaint Summary:

A complaint was submitted against a registrant (respondent) of the College alleging unethical conduct, in particular, the allegations were that the respondent breached the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct:

Principle 7: Maintain a standard of personal and professional conduct that does not reflect adversely on the College or its registrants.

Principle 8: Avoid injuring the reputation of others through malice or negligence. The complaint alleged the respondent conducted work that was not required and charged the client for said work and b) breached confidentiality by providing the result of the work to a third party, therefore breaching confidentiality.

Decision:

The Investigations Committee dismissed the complaint under Part 9; Section 9-8 1(e) of the College Bylaws while advising on the College's expectations for adherence to the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct and the Office of the Superintendent of Professional Governance Best Practices for Professional Communications.
