### Complaint Summary:

A complaint was submitted against a former registrant (respondent) of the College alleging that the respondent failed to respond to requests for information from the College. The allegations were that the respondent failed to comply with section 9-4(3) of the College's bylaws, and breached Principle 9 of the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct:

- Principle no. 9: Recognize the duty to address poor conduct and/or practice of another professional under the Professional Governance Act in order to protect the public interest, the profession, and the reputation of the College as a regulator.

### Decision:

The Investigations Committee reviewed the complaint and issued a citation on July 24, 2023. The Investigations Committee rescinded the citation and dismissed the complaint on April 16, 2024. The committee determined that it was not in the public interest to pursue this matter because it was addressed by the terms of the March 7, 2024 consent order for complaint file 21-10.
