That you are in breach of section 7-1(1) of the *College Bylaws* and Principles 2(4), 2(6), and 2(7) of Schedule 1 of the *College Bylaws* (the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct) by failing to respond to client communications in connection with a Riparian Assessment you were contracted to perform.
- 2. That you are in breach of section 9-4(3) of the *College Bylaws* and Principle 7(b) of Schedule 1 of the *College Bylaws* (the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct) by failing to respond to requests for information from the College in respect of a complaint made against you.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Rule 9-15(4)(a) of the *College Bylaws* you have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by legal counsel in the process of responding to the allegations set out above;

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that in the event you do not respond to this citation or otherwise participate in the hearing process, the discipline panel may, upon proof of service of the Notice of Hearing upon you, proceed to make its findings and decision without further notice to you.
