Complaint Summary:

A complaint was submitted against a member of the College alleging professional misconduct in conducting a RAR assessment on a property. The Complainant alleged that the College members was in violation of:

Principle 1 – Provide objective, science-based, unfettered, forthright and intellectually honest opinion, advice and reports in applied biology.

Principle 3 –Ensure they meet a professional standard of care by practicing applied biology with attention, caution, prudence, and due diligence.

Decision:

An investigation was conducted which required additional information from the complainant and information from the B.C. Provincial Government.

After reviewing all documents and responses from the complainant, subject member and the B.C. Provincial Government, the Committee determined that the subject member did not contravene the Rules of the college and the complaint was dismissed.
