POSITION SUMMARY	Roe Environmental Inc. is seeking environmental professionals to provide fish assessment services to support the environmental monitoring program at the Woodfibre LNG project near Squamish, BC. This field-based role requires demonstrated technical experience in fish salvage operations, juvenile salmon identification, environmental data collection, and marine-based field operations.
POSITION TERM	Temporary contract position from January 20 – May 31 , with a strong potential for continued employment at Woodfibre LNG or with Roe Environmental’s Lower Mainland operations Shift work – 14 days on / 7 days off with potential for night shift work
POSITION LOCATION	The position will primarily involve field work at and near the Woodfibre LNG project in Squamish, BC. Candidates from outside of the Squamish area can expect to be housed in a private room on the Floatel (converted cruise ship) moored on site during their shift. All meals are provided.
