

Interpretation Document: RETIRED REGISTRANTS AND VOLUNTEERING

This guideline provides clarity regarding Bylaw 5-8(1)(b) – Requirements for Registration as a Retired Registrant in which a registrant must submit a declaration that the registrant is no longer practicing applied biology and does not intend to practice in the future.

Interpretation

This bylaw does not preclude retired registrants from volunteering for organizations in which applied biology is a focus. However, retired registrants must not be offering professional advice which falls within the regulated and reserved practice of applied biology as defined in the *Applied Biologists Regulation*.

Where an individual or organization is going to rely on the professional advice provided, that information may only be provided by an active registrant within their scope of practice
